



**THE 2021 ROBERT W. LIBBEY
CHINESE LANGUAGE SCHOLARSHIP
FOR NAVY AND MARINE VETERANS**

The Department of Asian Languages and Literature is now accepting applications for the 2021 Robert W. Libbey Chinese Language Scholarship for Navy and Marine Veterans. The scholarship awards between \$3,000 and \$6,000 to one or more qualified continuing undergraduate or graduate students for use during the following academic year.

Qualifications

Qualified students will

- a) be Navy or Marine veterans;
- b) be declared Chinese majors, minors, MA, or PhD students, or plan to be enrolled in Chinese language during the entire following academic year;
- c) have exemplary academic records.

Application Process

Applications for scholarships must include:

- a) brief statement from the applicant describing their academic and career goals;
- b) proof of Navy or Marine veteran status;
- c) one letter of recommendation.

Announcements of awards will be made at the department's spring Convocation and Awards Ceremony.
