Title: Tacoma Transportation Electrification and Alternative Fuels

Abstract: De-carbonization of the transportation sector is a key policy goal of state and local governments, and utilities are vital to that effort. Cam will describe the challenges and opportunities Tacoma Power has encountered along the way and will share a few lessons learned. Be aware that this talk will be more philosophical than technical and seeks to contribute to an overall understanding of how utilities can address electrification of the transportation system.

Bio: Cam LeHouillier is the Manager of Energy Research and Development at Tacoma Power. Cam and his team manage and support over a dozen project teams that investigate new technologies and develop new utility programs, including transportation electrification.

Cam has 25 years of experience working in power and natural gas utilities in many different roles including; Finance, Regulatory, Wholesale Energy Trading, Energy Risk Management, and Strategic Resource Planning. He has worked for Union Gas (now Enbridge), Enron Corporation, Puget Sound Energy, Seattle City Light, and for the last 13 years at Tacoma Power.
